Matthew W. Hughey is Professor of Sociology at the University of Connecticut. He is a 2022 Fulbright Scholar at the University of Surrey and was a 2019 Gambrinus Fellow at TU Dortmund.

Hughey's research focuses on the relationship between the heterogeneous interpretations of race and the long-term staying power of racism and racial inequality. He has authored over eighty articles and nine books, including the award-winning ethnography, *White Bound: Nationalists, Antiracists, and the Shared Meanings of Race* (Stanford University Press 2012).
